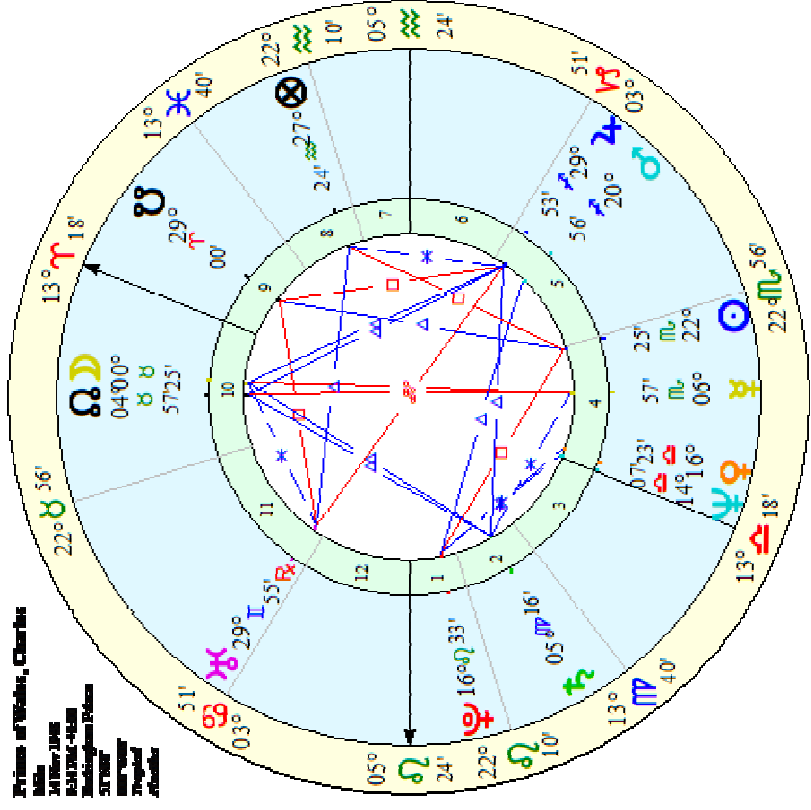

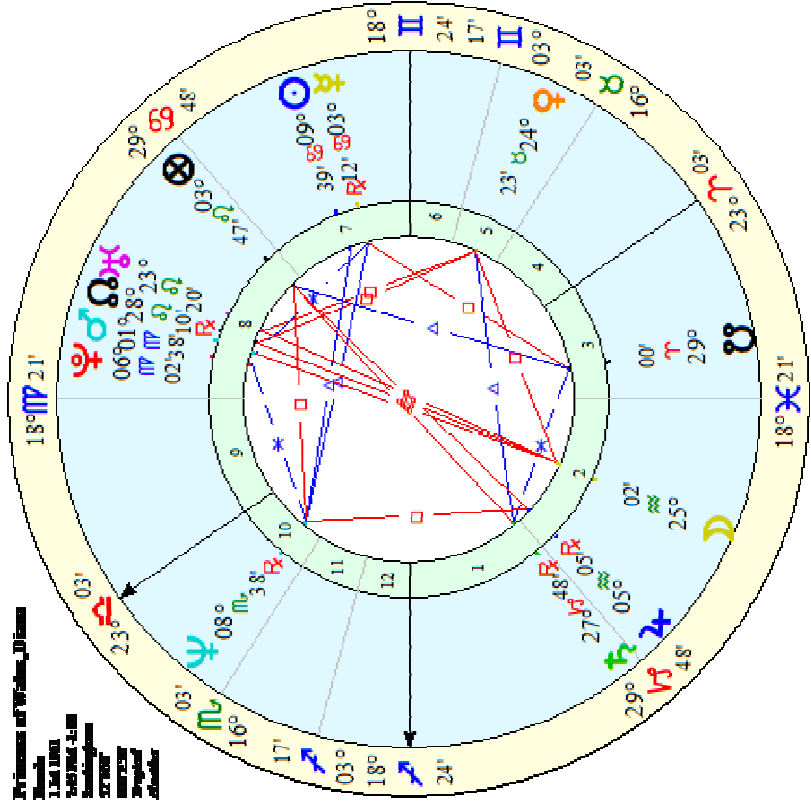

Introduction

This report has been written to introduce you to the concepts of astrology and how to get started in relationship astrology. Astrology is a complex and meaningful science which takes years to study and apply successfully; however, we would like to whet your appetite with this report, and encourage you to deepen your understanding through other means.

Astrology is a study of the connection between planets and life on Earth. It is based on a concept that energy patterns form between other planets and Earth and that these energies affect our lives as individuals and communities.

An astrological chart, also known as a horoscope, natal chart, or birth chart, records the relationship between the planets and the signs of the Zodiac. Charts can be calculated for the birth of a person, a community, an event or anything that seems momentous. The horoscope is as individual and unique as a fingerprint.

When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection your chart, as it is likely that you do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in your life. Usually it is the responsibility of an astrologer to synthesise these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

Please also be aware of the fact that each person has positive and negative influences in the chart, and therefore in their lives. The challenge is to accept and overcome the negative influences, so that we can successfully focus on the positive traits. This report outlines the influence of both people's charts on each other. This is called relationship synastry meaning the comparison of two horoscopes and the correlations discovered. It is likely that the report will show both the strengths and weaknesses of the relationship synastry. Any advice given is meant to be an aid to a person taking responsibility for their own lives and their own choices within a relationship. The ultimate decision rests with each individual. Individual Relating Traits

This section looks at each person's individual relationship concerns in their own personal birth chart. Every individual brings certain needs and expectations into a union, which affect his or her ability to feel loved and supported. This in turn affects the nature and course of the relationship.

Traits of Charles

Venus is in the 4th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the fourth house of your birth chart relationships with your family are important. Your home and family are your refuge from the world. Whether you live on your own or with other members of your family, you like nothing better than to return home to a peaceful environment where you can relax and enjoy comfort and, if applicable, pleasant conversation. While some people might enjoy a boisterous household, you prefer a pleasant and harmonious environment. Your home is a showpiece, as you enjoy decorating and entertaining. Your garden, whether small or large, is also scenic. You like to have a sense of home and family, enjoying the company of your family members, particularly the women. Your life partner needs to respect this side of your nature, or better still, enjoy sharing the pleasures of your home and family.

Venus is in Libra

With Venus in the sign of Libra you enjoy the company of other people and tend to fill your life with people from all walks of life, although you do have a preference for people from the higher echelons of society. Your diary is filled with social occasions ranging from quiet chats with one or two friends, to larger gatherings of your loved ones. In fact it might help if you're able to escape with your loved one to a romantic setting, away from the demands of everyday life. Coming to terms with the reality of your relationship simply helps you obtain a better understanding of your primary relationship, and helps prevent you becoming disillusioned. In other words taking off the rose-coloured glasses means that you can make a proper assessment of your primary relationship. As a result you'll experience fewer feelings of resentment and disappointment because your partner fails to be perfect, and you won't be in danger of overlooking some major flaws such as drug addiction or deceit. With the right partner you'll enjoy a sense of peace and fulfillment. You may also enjoy artistic or spiritual pursuits together. You're ardent and loving, responding quickly to your partner's need. In turn you benefit from acts of kindness, love and appreciation.

Venus is Sextile Pluto

The combination of the planets Venus and Pluto in your chart indicate that you enjoy commitment and challenge in your personal relationships. Unlike many other people, you're not afraid to make the necessary changes demanded within close relationships. In fact you prefer change, especially if the alternative is a staid and steady relationship. You like to be consumed with love and passion, and are happiest when with a partner who feels the same way. You can be disappointed when others fail to soar to great emotional heights and plummet the emotional depths by your side. You want intensity, perhaps even a little drama, in your primary relationship. You're fiercely loyal and committed, and expect as much from your partner. Problems can arise when you don't feel a strong bond with your partner, or if a third partner threatens your relationship. You're a jealous person, and quite capable of seeking revenge when wronged. You need to be careful to choose the right person as your primary partner - someone who reciprocates your love and passion. Otherwise you can waste a lot of time and energy trying to make a doomed relationship work. You may also benefit from directing some of your energy into an all-consuming project, such as fighting for human rights or an intensely creative pursuit.

Traits of Diana

Venus is in the 10th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the tenth house of your birth chart professional relationships are important. Success and honour are likely to favour your doorstep. Both your career and your primary relationship are favoured by this beneficial placement of the planet Venus. Depending on other influences in your birth chart, you succeed in your professional

ambitions and in attracting a primary partner of high status. It's possible that you marry above your station. You enjoy pleasurable professional relationships, particularly with women, and can create a harmonious and comfortable atmosphere in the workplace. This leads to greater productivity, either your own or other people's. Your professional attitude to work, and harmonious working relationships, usually results in good promotional prospects and increases in salary. Your career may be linked with decorating, beauty products, women's interests, personnel management or any field that requires teamwork. Your life partner needs to respect the emphasis that you place on your career and professional contacts. In some cases you may meet your spouse through your professional contacts, or share the same profession as your loved one.

Uranus is in the 7th House

The planet Uranus is in the seventh house of your birth chart suggesting that you've a need for unconventional relationships. Depending on other aspects in your birth chart, these relationships have a positive or negative effect on your life. On a positive note you attract an unusual primary partner, someone who is original or involved in an unusual occupation, perhaps even a genius in his or her field. Venus is in Libra

Venus is Trine Saturn

The planets Venus and Saturn have combined in your chart indicating that you're seeking commitment and security in your primary relationship. Positively speaking this can be a rewarding, long-term relationship with someone trustworthy and reliable. You're faithful and loyal, a dependable, stable and dutiful partner. You value a long-lasting relationship, and are willing to take your time in establishing a permanent partnership. As a young adult you may favour a traditional marital relationship, complete with a formal ceremony and traditional wedding vows. This could change later in adulthood, when you're more likely to consider commitment in other forms. You're likely to achieve your objective of a worthwhile, long-term relationship after careful consideration and planning. On the other hand if you're not careful you may become involved with someone who tries to control your movements and behaviour. Depending on other influences in your chart you may be shy and inhibited in your personal relationships, and be fearful of standing up for your rights. One of your parents may have been too strict, eroding your confidence and ability to make your own way in the world. Consequently you fear expressing yourself, particularly in intimate relationships, and harbour feelings of being unattractive. While your personal relationships may prove difficult you've the ability to form good business partnerships. This is probably because business partners don't require intimacy or emotional vulnerability, which you find frightening. It's also possible that you're attracted to someone much older or perhaps your primary partner is also your business partner. The good news is that once you overcome your feelings of inadequacy you've the ability to form secure and long-lasting relationships based on firm foundations.

Venus is Square The Moon

You're likely to experience problems in your relationships, particularly your relationships with women. This is because of the difficult combination of the Moon and the planet Venus in your chart. On the one hand you could tend to take your relationships for granted, spending little time or effort on improving yourself or your friendships. As a result you're likely to be somewhat unpopular and lose face. If you're looking for favours from your friends, or for a satisfactory primary relationship, then you need to take stock and improve your attitude. On the other hand it's also possible that your friends tend to take you for granted. On a more positive note you enjoy the company of other people, and may benefit through your relationships with women, but probably only with some effort on your behalf.

Venus is Square Uranus

The planets Venus and Uranus are combining unfavourably in your chart indicating that you're restless and often lack commitment in your personal relationships. This can lead to disappointments and complications in love and marriage, particularly in your early adult life. It's also possible that your roving eye can lead to scandal. You're willful and often perceive your primary partnership as demanding too much time and effort, an obstacle to your freedom of self-expression. You seek spontaneity and intellectual stimulation from your primary relationship. Unless other influences contradict this aspect of your birth chart, commitment is not a major part of your vocabulary, and can be something that you tend to avoid, preferring to be "footloose and fancy free". This isn't to say that you don't have many offers. Quite the contrary. Your bright and magnetic personality attracts potential life partners like moths to a flame, but you prefer to keep your options open rather than be pinned down. Depending on

other aspects in your chart you may be satisfied with a gypsy-like approach to relationships. You may also like intrigue and secrecy in your relationships, perhaps even taking part in a secret organisation. However, if other influences are calling for commitment and permanency in a primary partnership, then you need to choose a partner who is able to give you plenty of freedom. You're more suited to an unconventional relationship. You also need to learn to compromise, restrain some of your wilder urges, and enjoy your partner's unique contribution to your life. It's possible that the restless side of your nature is more prominent in relationships, which have formed through friendship or through fleeting attraction rather than through true love. With the right person, you're able to develop your talents and strengths in a positive and supportive relationship.

Synastry Between Charles and Diana

Personal Issues

This section looks at the interaction between two people and their two birth charts. It notes the nature of the relationship, whether it is likely to be a successful personal relationship or whether the forces at work are suggesting a less intimate bond. In other words how do these two people come together on an intimate level?

Charles's Moon is Sextile Diana's Mercury (Orb 2°46')

This is an ideal combination for a personal relationship in which two people enjoy ease of communication. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company because they are able to communicate comfortably. They enjoy discussions and are not concerned about arguments. Many personal relationships fail simply because two people are unable to communicate both their thoughts and feelings. The synastry of these two planets means that Charles and Diana are able to tell each other not only what they are thinking, but also how they are feeling. They are able to do so in a manner that is not threatening or hurtful to each other. Therefore Charles and Diana are both safe in the knowledge that they are not going to overreact, trampling on each other's feelings. Likewise Charles and Diana are easily able to acknowledge the value of each other's thoughts and feelings. At times Charles and Diana may even feel they are telepathic together, seemingly not needing words to communicate but understanding each other's unspoken thoughts. Together Charles and Diana are able to take a balanced approach combining passion and reason. They have an understanding and rapport that enables them to clarify their own thoughts and feelings. Charles is likely to be the more intuitive of the two, while Diana is likely to rely more on the intellect when communicating.

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's Mars (Orb 1°12')

This combination of planets denotes a relationship that is exciting and animated. Charles and Diana's discussions are lively and impassioned and their shared pastimes are also likely to be energetic and fun. Charles and Diana enjoy spontaneity and both tend to be impulsive when together. Both of them feel that their lives have become more effervescent with the advent of this relationship. Charles is most likely to feel that Diana brings excitement into his life. Charles is aware that Diana's drive and energy contributes positively to his life. Whereas Diana feels inspired by the relationship to achieve her goals. Diana acknowledges that Charles's support and understanding is helping her to advance in life. There is also likely to be a strong sexual attraction that helps to add a little spice to life. However, this sexual attraction is most powerful when both Charles and Diana are feeling comfortable within the association. The attraction can lose its spark when there is emotional tension. Fortunately, this does not happen often. Charles

and Diana are mostly able to resolve their differences and enjoy an enlivened and satisfying union.

Diana's Moon is Square Charles's Sun (Orb 2°36')

'Opposites attract' could be the theme for this combination of personal planets. There is an instant spark when Diana and Charles meet, whether they choose to enjoy a friendship or a more intimate relationship. The world seems more exciting when they are together. When together Diana and Charles are able to broaden their horizons in ways they had not thought possible. Each one seems to fill a void deep inside the other. In astrology it is considered important to have a combination of personal planets in order to enjoy a deep relationship, but this can be a difficult combination once the initial excitement has worn off. Friction easily arises and what was once attractive becomes irritating. The success of this relationship largely depends on each person's ability to accept the other person's differences. Charles may eventually have difficulty understanding Diana's emotional nature. Charles may feel impatient and frustrated by the limitations placed on him by Diana. Diana may feel overwhelmed by Charles's personality. The initial excitement of the association with someone so opposing in nature may be replaced by feelings of insecurity. It's important for both Diana and Charles to continue to appreciate each other's differences at all times and to realise that this relationship is potentially very rewarding if the difficulties can be faced and resolutions found.

Diana's Sun is Trine Charles's Mercury (Orb 2°42')

The importance of communication in relationships cannot be emphasised enough. Without understanding of another person's point of view and the ability to communicate one's own thoughts and feelings a relationship can easily break down. This is an ideal combination for harmonious communications in a relationship. Diana and Charles are able to communicate with ease, understanding how the other person thinks and sharing many of the same opinions. On the occasions when Diana and Charles do disagree, they do so with a respect for each other's point of view. Diana and Charles enjoy learning from each other and may take part in a shared activity or pastime from which they both learn about themselves and life. Both Diana and Charles enjoy listening to each other, as well as talking. They may also enjoy writing notes to each other. Together they learn a greater understanding of each other and themselves. Diana has a great respect for Charles's intellectual prowess and may even help him to develop his mental skills. Diana knows that Charles helps her to shine more in her own life through the intellectual stimulation that comes from this relationship. In response Charles knows that Diana's sunny personality stimulates him and that he is appreciated. Diana helps him to grow in his awareness of the world.

Charles's Sun is Opposite Diana's Venus (Orb 1°58')

This combination of the Sun and the personal planet Venus in relationship astrology is a difficult one. It indicates that the two people have conflicting values when it comes to personal relationships, which creates problems for any long-term association. Charles and Diana feel a strong attraction to each other, but they cannot seem to communicate in a harmonious manner. Joint decisions about relationships are difficult. Charles and Diana argue about subjects such as the future of their relationship, family associations, money matters and

creative pastimes. They just can't seem to agree. Charles feels frustrated. On the one hand Charles is drawn to Diana. On the other hand Charles knows that he is losing his identity in this relationship, and is often floundering to express himself. Diana is also frustrated. She feels overwhelmed by Charles's powerful personality and is unable to get on with her creative pursuits. Neither Charles nor Diana really feels that they are benefiting from this union, and yet they feel drawn to try to resolve the problems. Depending on other connections in this relationship Charles and Diana may finally decide to end their association or they could resolve their differences. They may need to seek counsel on how to resolve their differences.

Charles's Mercury is Trine Diana's Mercury (Orb 3°45')

Communication plays a central role in the success of any relationship whether it be a love union, friendship or work association. This combination indicates a meeting of true minds. Charles and Diana are able to converse easily with each other, sharing the stimulation of exchanging thoughts and opinions. Perhaps they also share a similar outlook on life. Charles and Diana understand each other and feel at ease together, enjoying each other's company. Lively conversations and shared pastimes feature in this relationship. They are able to appreciate each other's sense of humour and make light of any difficult arguments, often finding a creative way of approaching problematic subjects. In other words this is a harmonious combination and augurs well for the relationship. It is likely that Charles and Diana's communication takes the form of letter writing or the exchanging of notes, or perhaps even electronic mail. Whatever the form of communication it is important that both Charles and Diana keep in touch. This is an ideal combination for a personal love relationship and friendship. It is also beneficial for a work association, which requires an intelligent and energetic approach to a joint project or task.

Charles's Venus is Sextile Diana's Ascendant (Orb 2°01')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Charles's Venus is combining with Diana's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant personal relationship. Charles and Diana feel strongly drawn to each other, experiencing a sense of completeness in each other's company. Charles is in love with Diana, wanting to enjoy pleasurable activities and intimate moments. He appreciates the benefits that this union brings into his life. This relationship brings a wealth of benefits for Charles. In turn Diana has a greater sense of well being through her association with Charles. She appreciates Charles's love of intimacy and his attitude to this union. Together they share a mutual respect and affection. While this combination is most likely to indicate an intimate love union, it can also augur well for friendships, family relationship and work associations.

Charles's Mars is Conjunct Diana's Ascendant (Orb 2°32')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Charles's Mars is combining with Diana's Ascendant making for a lively and energetic union. While it is most likely that this relationship is an intimate one, it can also indicate a friendship, family or work association. In most cases this combination is a positive one, but it can also denote a union in which conflict is difficult to

resolve and as a result battles abound. On a positive note Charles provides the initiative to help Diana achieve her goals. Diana appreciates the drive and direction provided by Charles. Problems may arise when Charles turns his attention away from the relationship disappointing Diana with his lack of support. The challenge is for both Charles and Diana to keep this relationship moving in a positive direction through understanding and patience.

Primary Forces

In addition to the intimate aspect of a relationship, there are usually a number of fundamental driving forces, which can be either major challenges or inspirations to the individuals involved. This section looks at how Charles and Diana stimulate and provoke each other.

Diana's Moon is Trine Charles's Uranus (Orb 4°53')

The saying 'expect the unexpected' could be applied to this combination of Diana and Charles's planets. There is an element of excitement and adventure when Diana and Charles get together. They both enjoy the thrill of being in each other's company exploring new territories together. Many relationships start with the thrill and ardour of romance only to have it fade with the routine of daily life. However, Diana and Charles know how to keep the exhilaration for the long term. In particular Diana is very attracted to Charles, acknowledging that Charles adds a lot of spice to her life. She feels life is more joyful since she has met Charles. Diana may be the one to nurture some of Charles's more adventurous plans or she may simply enjoy going along for the ride. Charles feels that Diana gives him companionship and comfort prompting him to new heights of innovative ideas and activities. It's possible that both Diana and Charles enjoy an unusual and innovative hobby or work project. This is a fun combination for a personal union, but will need other connections between two people's planets to cement a long-term intimate relationship. This combination is also ideal for less personal relationships such as friendships or a working project that requires creative and innovative ideas.

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's Pluto (Orb 5°36')

This is an intense and powerful relationship. Charles and Diana feel a strong attraction to each other, one that seems to constantly draw them together. Sexual attraction may be powerful. Charles's and Diana's deep feelings for each other need to be nurtured in a loving manner in order for the union to be long lasting. This relationship can be a positive or a negative experience, depending on how Charles and Diana handle intense feelings. Some individuals thrive on intensity, while others feel threatened and powerless. Charles is likely to feel that Diana has transformed his life in some way. It's possible that Diana has changed the way that Charles feels about the world, making him conscious of things that have been bubbling under the surface for a long time. Life is not the same for Charles once he encounters Diana. Charles is able to see through the explosive behaviour to the true heart of Diana and to nurture Diana's goodness in ways that she has not previously encountered. As a result Diana deeply appreciates the emotional support offered by Charles. This is indeed a passionate union.

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's North Node (Orb 2°15')

Both the Moon and the Nodes individually are significant in relationship astrology. The combination of the Moon and the Nodes indicates that this is an important personal relationship, one that changes the course of Charles's life and deeply affects Diana. Charles and Diana feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. Whether the path of this relationship is smooth or rough, Charles and Diana's paths were meant to cross. The nature of this association depends largely on other aspects of Charles and Diana's charts. Passion may ignite if the right ingredients are involved, or friendship may be most appropriate choice of relationship.

Charles's Moon is Square Diana's Jupiter (Orb 4°39')

Although there can be some difficulties with this combination, on the whole this is a positive combination. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company and feel a certain zest for life when together. Charles and Diana share a need for fun-filled adventures and the capability of achieving their goals. They both feel that the world is their oyster which is ready to explore together. This can include holidays in far-away places, adventure travel and also encompasses any activity which expands their minds and views of life. This is a meeting of higher-minds. Charles feels that Diana expands his horizons. Charles feels safe and appreciated in this relationship. Diana knows that Charles is a comrade in arms when it comes to fun and adventure. Diana knows that she is truly appreciated for her generosity and optimism. Together Charles and Diana can conquer the world. Nothing seems too far-fetched. And this is where problems can lie. It is possible that neither Charles nor Diana know when enough is enough. There is a saying that 'you can have too much of a good thing'. This is one of the underlying problems of this association. Charles and Diana need to make sure that they do not become too grandiose in their dreams. Overinflated ideas of their capabilities are not helpful and can lead both Charles and Diana into troubled waters. Another complication can arise if Charles and Diana do not share the same values, because morals and beliefs play an important role in this relationship. However, if Charles and Diana share the same beliefs and can exercise some restraint this can be a positive combination for a long-term relationship.

Charles's Moon is Square Diana's Saturn (Orb 2°37')

Many astrologers believe that a connection between the serious planet Saturn and a personal planet such as the Moon is important, enabling the relationship to be long lasting. However, this can also be a difficult connection. Charles and Diana can both suffer from feelings of discontent and insecurity within this union. They work hard to cover up their sense that some emotional warmth is lacking, but there are times when they despair of getting their needs met. Charles feels this lack of emotional warmth keenly. It is difficult for him to relax and feel truly appreciated in this relationship. Diana brings a certain coldness to the union, finding it difficult to generate emotional warmth. Diana may feel that her attempts at intimacy are misunderstood and met with an overly-emotional reaction from Charles. Much work needs to be done in order to understand each other. On a positive note this combination of planets can indicate a committed to resolve difficulties. Therefore Charles and Diana have the strong

possibility of being able to stay in this relationship on a long-term basis and reap the rewards of a stable and secure union. A satisfying relationship can result from Charles's and Diana's patience and persistence.

Charles's Moon is Opposite Diana's Neptune (Orb 8°12')

Romance is a major theme in a union that involves the Moon and the planet Neptune. With this combination of planets Charles and Diana both feel that they are meant to be together. Perhaps they believe that it is a union of their souls. This is the height of romantic love. However, with romantic love there is always the possibility of disillusionment. Charles and Diana are likely to stumble across obstacles in this relationship because of unrealistic and overly idealistic expectations of each other. It is difficult for them to maintain the heights of love first attained at the beginning of the relationship. Misunderstandings can easily arise. After the first flush of love Charles feels that his emotional needs are being ignored, that Diana does not understand him. It is even possible that Charles feels that Diana is being deceptive in some manner. There is a danger that Diana does feel the need to hide behind a facade, failing to be her true self. Perhaps Diana feels that she cannot live up to Charles's expectations. Despair within this relationship needs to be avoided by both Charles and Diana facing their feelings of loss in previous relationships. They need to face the problems honestly in order to avoid the breakdown of trust and ultimately the relationship. As a result Charles and Diana may be able to recapture their sense of belonging together which was so strong in the initial stages of their union.

Diana's Moon is Square Charles's Chiron (Orb 3°11')

Compassion is needed if this union is to overcome the difficulties presented by this combination of the Moon and the asteroid Chiron. Ultimately this can be a healing relationship, one that presents both Diana and Charles with opportunities to heal past emotional wounds and head in new directions. However, initially they have to overcome old hurts that stand in the way of honest communication. Unwittingly, Charles is likely to spark Diana's painful memories. This could be by saying the wrong thing at the wrong time, or by his actions. Diana's memories may have been forgotten; only surfacing in fragments. Diana may have difficulty connecting the current day events with the past associations. Either way the force of Diana's reactions may surprise both Diana and Charles. The onus is on Diana to find a way to understand her emotional reactions, to heal the past and move on in life with renewed self-confidence and understanding. Charles also needs to become more aware of the effects of his behaviour on other people. A gentle and loving approach is often needed. Perhaps Charles is preparing to become a teacher or healer and needs these valuable lessons.

Charles's Sun is Square Diana's Uranus (Orb 0°54')

This is a relationship full of verve and romance, particularly in the first throes of love. Charles and Diana are attracted to each other from the moment that they first meet and continue to experience excitement and joy in each other's company. Despite this sense of adventure, Charles and Diana may have trouble maintaining a committed, long-term relationship unless they both enjoy plenty of freedom. This combination of the Sun and the planet Uranus suggest more an erratic and thrilling relationship, rather than a stable one. This works well if both

Charles and Diana value their independence and have stimulating pursuits. However, the initial enthusiasm can fade if Charles and Diana begin to experience the need to accommodate each other's needs and desires in this union, to the detriment of their own interests. If Charles and Diana both like to maintain their individuality, the relationship works well. This is particularly true for Diana, who stresses her individuality and can be unwilling to adjust to the demands of a serious relationship unless she is given freedom to do her own thing. However, if Charles feels the need for more security and routine, then this can present problems. Diana may begin to feel overwhelmed by what she perceives as Charles's strong personality and may have problems showing a long-term commitment. Likewise Charles may believe that Diana stands in the way of him expressing his true nature. Either way this association brings something new and original into Charles and Diana's lives and they both feel enlivened as a result. The long-term success of this union may depend on other connections between Charles and Diana's astrology charts.

Diana's Sun is Square Charles's Neptune (Orb 4°27')

Romance and love are central themes of this relationship between the Sun and the planet Neptune. This can suggest a romantic liaison in which both people are blessed with a sense of being with the right person at the right time, or it can mean a friendship that is based on a joint artistic project or spiritual interest. Perhaps they enjoy spending time in the natural surroundings of the beach or countryside. Either way Diana and Charles are likely to enjoy escaping from the harsher realities of life into a world of their own creation. However, problems can arise when Diana and Charles start to sacrifice their own personal needs for a misguided perception about what is good for the relationship. This behaviour can erode the creative component of the union and both Diana and Charles may lose their self-confidence and direction in life. It is possible that, together, they may turn to drugs, alcohol or even crime in their attempts to maintain the loosening threads of their union. In particular, Diana needs to be wary of losing her sense of self. It would be easy for Diana to be deceived by Charles either through her own need to believe in a dream or through Charles's behaviour. Charles needs to be wary of becoming secretive and dishonest within this association. As the relationship develops Charles may become confused about the true meaning of his bond with Diana leading to a need to hide his true feelings. On a more positive note, Diana and Charles may have other more positive connections in their relationship astrology that enables them to work through their problems in a loving and compassionate manner.

Charles's Sun is Square Diana's North Node (Orb 5°45')

Destiny plays a strong role in Charles and Diana's relationship. There is an instant attraction, a spark that ignites the feelings of both Charles and Diana. However, fate can be a cruel mistress. This relationship is fraught with problems that Charles and Diana find difficult to understand and solve. In particular Diana feels that his light is hidden under bushel. She struggles to express her true self. Perhaps Diana owes Charles a favour that seems never to be full repaid or may Diana has an inexplicable sense of responsibility for Charles. Whatever the scenario both Charles and Diana face certain challenges before reaching a full understanding of this union.

Diana's Mercury is Sextile Charles's Saturn (Orb 2°03')

This is an excellent combination for an enduring relationship. Both Diana and Charles share a mutual respect for each other and are willing to work towards sound communication. They take each other seriously, and are likely to share an interest in a thought-provoking pastime or a business enterprise. Shared values also mean that this relationship has firm foundations for the long term. Diana and Charles realise early in their association that this is a lasting union. Therefore it is likely that they slowly and surely get to know each other, rather than rushing headlong into a relationship. As a result they eventually form a strong bond. Diana respects and learns from Charles's wisdom. She is better able to communicate her own thoughts and ideas thanks to Charles's well-received advice. Charles's organisational abilities shine in this relationship. He discovers different methods of approaching activities through his association with Diana.

Diana's Mercury is Conjunct Charles's Uranus (Orb 3°16')

This is an exciting and unpredictable relationship. Diana and Charles enjoy a lively union, whether it be a romance, friendship or work association. They take pleasure in topical conversations, sparking new ideas and ways of thinking. They may also enjoy taking part in an unusual activity or pursuing an environmental, humanitarian or political cause. This combination of planets indicates intellectual, rather than emotional, stimulation. Consequently this combination may indicate a friendship or work association, rather than a more personal union. However, an intimate relationship with other aspects is enhanced by this combination if both partners enjoy freedom. Diana and Charles are excited by each other's minds. In particular Diana realises that Charles sparks her creativity. Both Diana and Charles enjoy a new-found sense of freedom in each other's company.

Charles's Mercury is Conjunct Diana's Neptune (Orb 1°40')

This is an inspirational relationship whether it be a romance, friendship or a creative working partnership. Both Charles and Diana feel excited by this union. Their imaginations are enlivened. In particular Charles's ideas are encouraged by Diana's creative input, enabling him to better express himself. It's possible that they work together on a creative project. Communication has an easy flow, more intuitive than concrete. Charles and Diana establish an empathetic bond which enables them both to exchange their thoughts and feelings with ease. If involved in a romantic liaison then Charles and Diana are likely to feel very much in love, viewing their union through rose-coloured glasses. Whatever the nature of the relationship, it is likely that Charles and Diana share an interest in the arts, a spiritual path or a philanthropic activity.

Charles's Mercury is Sextile Diana's Pluto (Orb 0°54')

An intense relationship is the result of this combination of the planets Mercury and Pluto, with communication playing a key role. Consequently it is vital that both Charles and Diana communicate honestly, keeping all emotions and thoughts out in the open. This helps them to keep the relationship dynamic rather than volcanic. If Charles and Diana enjoy penetrating discussions and passionate pastimes then all is well. If they don't then their union could become overwhelming, particularly for Charles. Together they experience a change of

perception which is ultimately rewarding, although initially could be disruptive. Notably Diana challenges Charles's way of viewing the world. This can be an excellent combination for personal and spiritual growth. Consequently it is an ideal combination for a therapist and client relationship. It can also be beneficial for an intimate relationship or friendship, if both partners enjoy intensity, and a demanding working association.

Charles's Mercury is Trine Diana's Chiron (Orb 0°29')

Kind and gentle communication is an essential ingredient for success in this relationship. Through considerate interaction Charles and Diana can develop a warm and loving relationship, whether this be a love union, work association, student and teacher connection or friendship. There is a childlike quality to this liaison, possibly Charles and Diana share a love of children or enjoy recapturing some of their lost childhood. Through this relationship Charles learns a vital life lesson, one that furthers his spiritual journey. In some way Diana helps Charles to let go of intellectual insecurities, paving the way for a more wholesome approach to learning. It is possible that Charles is a student of Diana's. In return Diana realises new skills, in particular that of communicating information with compassion and empathy.

Diana's Mercury is Sextile Charles's North Node (Orb 1°45')

The North Node is a significant point in relationship astrology, indicating fate in any association. In this case Diana and Charles are destined to meet and learn from each. Perhaps they meet in a study group, as pen pals or at a college. Charles gains insight and understanding through his association with Diana. Perhaps Diana is a teacher imparting specific knowledge, or maybe Diana's presence communicates certain messages that are valuable for Charles's life lessons. Either way Diana and Charles are comfortable interacting with each other. Depending on aspects of Diana and Charles's birth charts, this association indicates an intellectual rapport rather than a passionate or emotional bond.

Charles's Mercury is Square Diana's Jupiter (Orb 1°51')

This combination of the planets Mercury and Jupiter can indicate a relationship in which both Charles and Diana are inspired by the meeting of two minds. However, it is important that they show some restraint in their activities. When Charles and Diana get together they are both eager to discover new worlds. They enjoy broadening their minds through overseas travel or by learning about different cultures in books and study courses. Philosophy, metaphysics and religion are topics of conversation which stimulate and expand their minds. It is also possible that Charles and Diana pursue activities connected with philanthropic or philosophical ideologies. In moderation this can be beneficial to the relationship. However, there is a tendency towards grandiosity. Both Charles and Diana encourage each other to greater feats of learning or adventure without realising when it is time to call a halt. This can result in irresponsible behaviour. They also need to be wary of becoming too gullible in their efforts to follow a personal philosophical belief. It is important that both Charles and Diana learn to temper their activities.

Diana's Venus is Opposite Charles's Chiron (Orb 3°49')

This combination of the planet Venus and the asteroid Chiron indicates a key relationship. Diana and Charles care for each other, either as friends, workmates or lovers. They both feel a strong bond and a need to protect and support each other through life's more traumatic moments. Both Diana and Charles have a strong commitment to helping each other heal the past and move forward. Perhaps relationships from the past provide an impetus for Diana and Charles to support each other, or perhaps it is present day circumstances. Either way they rally round whenever one is in trouble. In overcoming the difficulties this union brings a powerful sense of freedom, healing and joy.

Diana's Mars is Trine Charles's Jupiter (Orb 1°45')

Diana and Charles are able to combine their talents well under the positive influence of the planets Mars and Jupiter. Their association provides them both with a zest for life. Diana has the drive necessary for any joint projects, and Charles has the know-how and planning capabilities. Diana and Charles set goals, work towards them while overcoming obstacles along the way. Together they successfully achieve their ambitions. They enjoy collaborating, gaining the respect of each other in the process. Diana admires Charles's inspirational ideas. In turn Charles appreciates Diana's initiative and energy. As well as working together Diana and Charles also delight in playing together. It's possible that they enjoy sharing travel and sporting activities. Whatever joint project they undertake Diana and Charles enjoy good fortune.

Diana's Mars is Conjunct Charles's Saturn (Orb 3°37')

Commitment is a central theme to this relationship. Diana and Charles are striving to build something concrete whether it be a future together or work project. Together they have the strength and wisdom to achieve a shared ambition. This is not a flighty association. Both Diana and Charles are aiming for a long-term and stable partnership. For this reason the union is likely to involve a contract, perhaps a business or marriage contract. There may also be a strong sense of destiny linked with this union. Diana contributes the drive and initiative and Charles possesses the stability and practical aptitude. Diana wants to move forward, inspiring Charles to overcome obstacles that stand in their path. Diana is full of enthusiasm, whereas Charles is more cautious. At times Diana pushes Charles forward. At others Charles restrains Diana, proving that there is wisdom in a slow but sure path. Together they achieve success in their joint enterprises in the long term.

Charles's Mars is Trine Diana's Uranus (Orb 2°23')

Sexual attraction plays a key role in this relationship. Charles and Diana find each other's company exciting and feel compelled to explore an intimate relationship. They are aroused both in and out of the bedroom. The initial stages of the relationship are particularly stimulating, and the union continues to flourish as long as Charles and Diana give each other the freedom to follow their individual interests. The electric nature of Charles and Diana's association is such that they need time away from each other in order to slow down and experiences some tranquility in their separate lives. This is not a peaceful or stable relationship but rather one that offers ongoing stimulation and change. For this reason the relationship may be short-lived, a thrilling adventure which soon loses its spark through a lack of commitment.

However, other aspects of Charles and Diana's nature may provide the tenacity and steadiness needed for a long-term commitment. The challenge is to allow each other plenty of independence.

Diana's Mars is Trine Charles's North Node (Orb 3°18')

This combination of the planet Mars and the North Node indicates a fiery and fated relationship. This association makes a strong impact on both Diana and Charles whether they are lovers or enemies. It is also possible that Diana and Charles are involved in a dramatic or energetic project together. Whatever the path of this relationship, it is destined to change the course of their lives, in particular that of Charles. Passion and an intense desire to relate may be central to this relationship. However, it is also possible that arguments and violence are at the core of this association. The challenge for both Diana and Charles is to keep this association lively and positive so that fate can play its hand for the best possible outcome. In fact Charles may benefit directly through the role that Diana plays in his life.

Diana's Mars is Square Charles's Chiron (Orb 3°25')

This is a difficult and painful combination of the planet Mars and Chiron. Diana and Charles have difficulty overcoming past hurts and failures in their relationships. As a result their unresolved problems have an impact on this union. In particular Charles's insecurities have a profound effect on this liaison. Charles is sensitive because of bad experiences in previous relationships. This causes problems in this association, because unwittingly Charles reacts pessimistically to certain aspects of Diana's behaviour. Unless Diana always behaves in an understanding and compassionate manner, Charles takes offence. This is because Charles is predisposed to view Diana's actions in a negative light. It is possible that Diana lacks sympathy to Charles's problems, but not necessarily so. The onus is on both Diana and Charles to become aware of the problems so that they can heal these problems from the past and progress in a more joyful manner in their relationship.

Charles's Jupiter is Trine Diana's Pluto (Orb 6°09')

Charles and Diana are rejuvenated through their relationship. Life takes on a new glow from their first moment of meeting. In each other Charles and Diana have found a soul-mate, someone who understands them at a very deep, metaphysical level. As the relationship develops both Charles and Diana are challenged to reach deep within themselves in order to change and grow. Depending on their individual traits they can either enjoy this process of change or they can resist. Either way they are being dared to view their lives in a different and broader manner. Charles and Diana encourage each other in this growth process through co-operation and understanding. Together they feel able to overcome all obstacles. As a result it is likely that, through this union, both Charles and Diana begin to lead more creative lives.

Charles's Jupiter is Trine Diana's North Node (Orb 1°42')

The North Node indicates a significant and ordained contact. The planet Jupiter casts a beneficial influence. Therefore this is a positive and uplifting combination for any relationship. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company, both benefiting from the joy that is destined to enter their lives through this liaison. It is possible that Charles and Diana meet while travelling,

at a place of higher learning, in a sports arena or through a philosophical or religious organisation. Together they enjoy exploring any or all of these avenues of joint interests. Fate has smiled on this relationship.

Diana's Jupiter is Square Charles's North Node (Orb 0°08')

On the whole this is a joyful union. Diana and Charles enjoy each other's company, both benefiting from the joy that is destined to enter their lives through this liaison. It is possible that Diana and Charles meet while traveling, at a place of higher learning, in a sports arena or through a philosophical or religious organisation. Together they enjoy exploring any or all of these avenues of joint interests. However, both Diana and Charles need to set sensible limits on this union and any project undertaken together. Otherwise they may go overboard in their enthusiasm, egging each other on and taking unnecessary risks.

Charles's Pluto is Trine Diana's Ascendant (Orb 1°50')

Sparks fly when one person's Pluto connects with another person's Ascendant. This is a powerful combination indicating a dynamic relationship. Both Charles and Diana are intensely attracted to each other and stand to learn much about themselves and relationships under the influence of this combination. Charles has a particularly powerful role to play in Diana's life, shattering year-long habits and introducing an element of excitement. While Diana might initially feel uprooted and insecure as a result of the changes in her life, she comes to appreciate a sense of rejuvenation that comes with throwing out the old and welcoming the new. The success of this relationship depends on other aspects strengthening the long-term bond between Charles and Diana.

Generational Values

Underpinning the success of many relationships is a sense of shared values. Often this comes from simply being born into the same generation. However, sometimes it is more complex. In this section we explore whether or not Charles and Diana share the same societal values.

Charles's Saturn is Sextile Diana's Neptune (Orb 3°22')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. The planet Neptune indicates inspiration, imagination and dreams. So Charles and Diana feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This could be a personal relationship or a friendship that involves a spiritual, artistic or philanthropic project. Whatever the form of their relationship, Charles and Diana enjoy a meaningful bond. Charles and Diana both approach the relationship from different angles and need to respect each other's

differences in order for the relationship to succeed in the long term. Of course they may both agree that their union was destined to be for a short period only. When this association runs a smooth course Charles provides the structure and security, which enables Diana to fulfil her dreams. In some cases Charles may act as Diana's manager. In return Diana challenges Charles's fears, teaching him to break down certain boundaries and follow his dreams.

Charles's Saturn is Conjunct Diana's Pluto (Orb 0°46')

The combination of the planets Saturn and Pluto indicates that this is an important relationship, although not necessarily a personal one. Charles and Diana combine their talents in a way that enhances their lives. Charles provides structure and security so that Diana can safely make any changes necessary in her life. In return Diana helps Charles break through any barriers created by her fears. For these reasons this can be a dynamic and satisfying union.

Diana's Saturn is Sextile Charles's Chiron (Orb 0°24')

When Diana and Charles first meet, they experience a deep-seated feeling that they have met before. There is a sense in which both know that they are meeting in order to help each other learn more about their life's journey. Perhaps they have met in order to settle past scores or so that they can each leave behind painful relationship memories and build a new and more meaningful union. Although a certain feeling of discomfort can underlay this relationship, on the whole it is a positive one in which both Diana and Charles steadily grow more emotional secure. They are able to build firm foundations in this relationship, which augurs well for other areas of their lives.

Diana's Saturn is Sextile Charles's South Node (Orb 1°11')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. This is particularly true of connections between one person's Saturn and another person's Sun, Moon, Ascendant or Nodes. In this case Diana's Saturn is combining with Charles's Node indicating that this is a significant relationship. Diana and Charles feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This is a significant relationship.

Charles's Saturn is Opposite Diana's Chiron (Orb 1°12')

This union is fraught with difficulties, mainly because of Charles and Diana's past experiences in relationships. Hurtful experiences from previous important relationships initially have a negative impact hampering both Charles and Diana's ability to build a secure and loving relationship. However, both Charles and Diana are committed to each other, to making this relationship work. As a result past hurts are examined and healed in this union. It is possible that Charles fears emotional intimacy, at first putting up barriers that hinder the growth of this union. Perhaps he has trouble trusting the strength of the bond with Charles. Gradually Charles learns to trust the enduring nature of this relationship and both Charles and Diana learn the joys of intimacy.
